In the month of February we started working on our calendar in Spanish. We have a calendar in both English and Spanish. We go over the days of the week, month, season, and weather. What we are learning...

For the month of March we will learn Nursery Rhymes and Dr. Seuss, our pets, Leprechauns and Rainbows, and Life on a Farm. The letters that we will be learning are Rr-Yy. Please work on these letters at home. Other focus skills this month are:

Language & Literature: Tracking from left to right on a written page or teaching easel; Identify and understand parts of a book (cover, pages author, illustrator, etc), Comprehension and re-call ability to re-tell the main idea of a story in order, ability to memorize a song or chant, ability to use pictures and context to predict story content, opposites.

Social/Emotional Skills: Cooperation teamwork and respect.

Cognitive Development: Sorting, classifying and matching, proximity/understanding spatial relationships, sequence and patterning.

Motor Skills: Running, cutting, riding a tricycle, writing names, eye hand coordination and pincer grasp.

Science & Social Studies: Days of the week/months of the year, characteristics of and caring for animals.
